**ORDER GRANTING PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE'S CONSENT NOTICE AND
MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS: PARTIAL
COPY OF FEDERAL ESTATE TAX RETURN, FORM 706**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on the Personal Representative's Consent Notice and Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records, being a partial copy of Federal Estate Tax Return of Carl F. Eveleigh, Form 706, pursuant to *Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420*.

The Court, having reviewed the motion, having heard arguments at hearing, and having found that the degree, duration, and manner of sealing this exhibit from public access is no broader than necessary, and there is no less restrictive means to protect the interests of the parties as set forth in *Florida Rule of Judicial Procedure 2.420*, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The partial copy of Federal Estate Tax Return of Carl F. Eveleigh, Form 706, which was introduced into evidence at a January 28, 2014 Hearing on the Objection to Personal Representative's Amended Inventory, Petition for Discharge and Final Accounting filed by William C. Eveleigh, contains confidential information.

2. The Personal Representative's Consent Notice of Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records is hereby granted;

3. The Court will file said partial copy of Federal Estate Tax Return, Form 706 with the Clerk of Court under seal, and said document shall be sealed and exempt from public access and shall remain sealed until further Order of this Court.

5. In the Court record, said document may be viewed by a judicial officer, judicial staff, court administrative staff, counsel for the personal representative, and counsel for William C. Eveleigh, Jennifer Eveleigh, and Elizabeth Eveleigh.

6. Pursuant to *Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420*, the Clerk of Court shall post a copy of this order on the Clerk's website within 10 days of the rendition of this order, and it shall remain posted for of at least 30 days. The Clerk of Court shall post a copy of this order in a prominent, public location at the Duval County Courthouse within 10 days of this order, and it shall remain posted for a period of at least 30 days.

7. The progress docket and similar records generated to document activity in this case are not confidential and shall remain publicly available.

8. The names of the parties are not confidential. All parties shall remain known publicly through access to the court file.

9. This Order shall not be under seal.
