**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S  
MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS:  
FORMS 1041 (INCOME TAX RETURNS)**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on Plaintiff's Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420, the records being Forms 1041 (Income Tax Returns) offered into evidence by Plaintiff in this case on March 4, 2015.

The Court, having reviewed the Motion and being informed Defendants consent, and having found that the degree, duration, and manner of sealing this exhibit from public access is no broader than necessary, and there is no less restrictive means to protect the interests of the parties as set forth in Florida Rule of Judicial Procedure 2.420, hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. The 2012 Form 1041 for the Estate of Mary B. Eveleigh and the 2012 Form 1041 for the Mary B. Eveleigh Revocable Living Trust, which were offered into evidence

at the March 4, 2015 hearing in this case and Case No. 16-2014-CP-002357 as Plaintiffs' Exhibits 28 and 29, contain confidential information.

2. The Plaintiff's Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records is hereby granted.
3. The Court will file Plaintiffs' Exhibits 28 and 29 with the Clerk of Court under seal, and said documents shall be sealed and exempt from public access and shall remain sealed until further Order of this Court.
4. In the Court record, said document may be viewed by judicial officer, judicial staff, court administrative staff, counsel for the Plaintiffs and counsel for the Defendants.
5. Pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420, the Clerk of Court shall post a copy of this Order on the Clerk's website within 10 days of the rendition of this Order, and it shall remain posted for at least 30 days. The Clerk of Court shall post a copy of this Order in a prominent, public location at the Duval County Courthouse within 10 days of this Order, and it shall remain posted for a period of at least 30 days.
6. The progress docket and similar records generated to document activity in this case are not confidential and shall remain publicly available.
7. The names of the parties are not confidential. All parties shall remain known publicly through access to the court file.
8. This Order shall not be under seal.
