CONSENT ORDER TO MAKE COURT RECORDS CONFIDENTIAL

THIS CAUSE, come on to be heard without the necessity of a Court hearing due to all parties having consented to the entry of this Order, the Court, having reviewed the file and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, **FINDS:**

1. The parties have made allegations and disclosed certain information in the course of this case for civil theft and related torts through their respective pleadings and other filings which contain personal information and references to specific personal circumstances of which the parties are well aware (hereinafter referred to as "Confidential Information").

2. Disclosure of this Confidential Information would cause substantial injury to the parties and to innocent third parties and is, therefore, confidential under Rule 2.420(c)(9)(A)(v) and (vi) of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration.

3. The degree, duration and manner of the requested confidentiality of the Confidential Information are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in Paragraph 1 above.

4. No less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in Paragraph 1 above.

Upon consideration thereof, it is;

HEREBY, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED;

a. The Clerk of the Court is hereby directed to seal and treat as confidential the entire court file in this case.

b. Except for those persons named in any subsequent Order and under the conditions set forth in any such Order, the only persons who should have access to and be allowed inspection of the above-referenced Confidential Information are the Clerk of the Circuit Court in fulfillment of the Clerk of Court's duties.


c. The Clerk of Court is hereby directed to publish this Order in accordance with Rule 2.420(e)(4) of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration.


