**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION  
TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

THIS MATTER having come to be heard upon Defendant's Unopposed Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records and the Court, having reviewing the Unopposed Motion and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is hereby **ORDERED:**

1. Defendant's Unopposed Motion is **GRANTED**.
2. The confidentiality of the information sought to be sealed is required to protect the following interest under Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9)(A):
  - vi. Avoiding substantial injury to a party by the disclosure of matters protected by a common law or privacy right not generally inherent in this type of proceeding.
3. The Court finds that no less restrictive measure is available to protect this interest, and that the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect the interest.

4. Pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9) and Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.420(e), the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Duval County is hereby **ORDERED** to seal the following documents filed in Duval County Clerk of Court Case No. 2021-CF-3570:

- a. Defendant's Unopposed Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records filed December 17, 2021;
- b. This Court's Order granting same upon entry;
- c. Defendant's Unopposed Motion to Unseal Select Hearing Transcript – Chanard Cannon Bond Hearing filed on December 17, 2021;
- d. This Court's Order granting same upon entry;
- e. Defendant's Unopposed Motion to Unseal Select Hearing Transcript – Janera Smith Bond Hearing filed on December 17, 2021;
- f. This Court's Order granting same upon entry.


5. It is further **ORDERED** that any materials sealed pursuant to this Order shall be conditionally disclosed upon the Court's entry of a subsequent order finding that such opening is necessary for purposes of judicial or governmental accountability of First Amendment rights.

- a. That any materials sealed pursuant to this Order may otherwise be disclosed only as follows:
  - i. to any judge of this Circuit for case-related reasons;
  - ii. to the Chief Judge or his or her designee;
  - iii. to adult named parties or their attorneys of record; or
  - iv. by further order of the Court.

6. That the Clerk is hereby directed to post within ten (10) days following the entry of this Order a copy of the Order on the clerk's website and on the "Public Notice Bulletin Board" located in the Clerk's Office, Duval County Courthouse for a period of thirty (30) days.

7. That the Clerk is hereby authorized to unseal any materials sealed pursuant to this Order for the purpose of filing, microfilming, or imaging files, or transmitting a record to an appellate tribunal. The materials shall be re-sealed immediately upon completion of the filing.
